

## CHARTLET FOR THE DEBEN ENTRANCE

Imray's chartlet for the Deben entrance follows on the next page of this PDF. It was drawn from a Trinity House survey carried out in May 2015, and is the second chartlet to be issued this year – *make sure you are using the correct version.*

Skippers needing any further advice on the spot can call ECP's local Honorary Port Pilot, and Deben Harbourmaster, John White, either on VHF Ch 08 callsign 'Odd Times', or by phone on 07803 476621.

He suggests leaving each buoy on its correct side, about 25 yards away.

Note that the Knoll Spit may be moved from time to time. For boats of 1.5m to 1.8m draught, John White says that to find plenty of water, arrive between HW-3 and HW+2. He stresses that skippers must take account of the cross tide which runs quite strongly, SW on the flood and NE on the ebb.

Overall, as ever with this river entrance, mariners should heed the advice given by Trinity House in their Notice to Mariners no. 8/15 C4, which said:

**“Mariners are advised to exercise extreme caution when navigating in this area due to a highly mobile seabed”.**

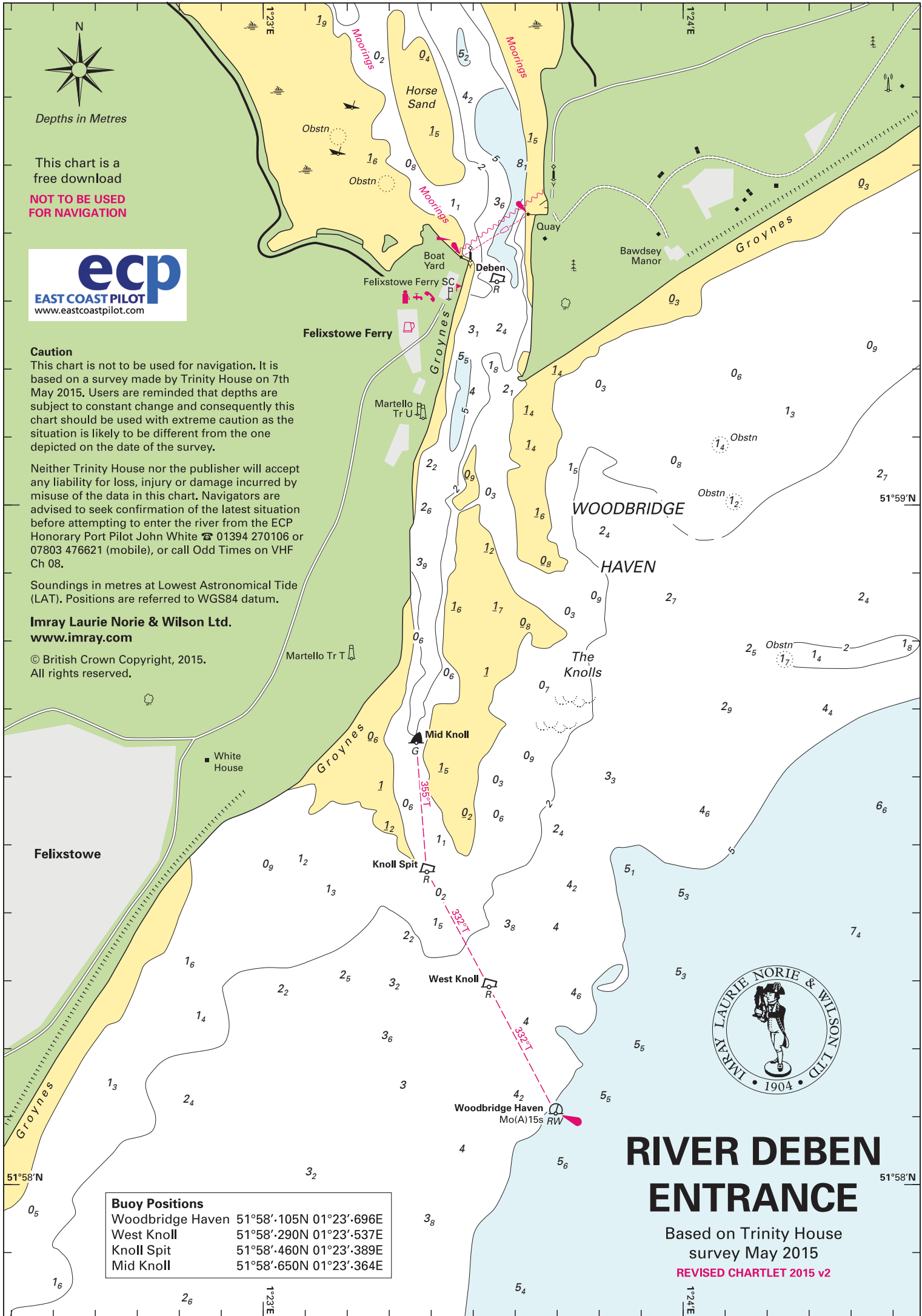
